

MARAS: Located in the province of Urubamba at 3300 m.s.n.m. from there you can see the Vilcanota mountain range and the snowy peaks: "El Chicón" (5530 m.s.n.m), "La Verónica" (5682 m.s.n.m). At present, this picturesque town keeps attractions of the PRE-Hispanic, colonial and republican period, highlighting in the town streets and colonial portals with shields of the nobles and caciques of the XVII and XVIII centuries.

MORAY: It is located about 7 km southwest of Maras and 53 km from Cusco with an altitude of 3,385 m.s. It is a unique archaeological group of its kind in the region. These are gigantic holes that were used by the Incas who built terraces or agricultural terraces with their respective irrigation channels, it is therefore a greenhouse prototype, the biggest hole has a depth of 150 m and an average height of platforms is 1.80 m, between each one of them.

After breakfast we will continue our walk this stretch is 15 km. Full of vegetation and number of Inca archaeological sites of different functions. The first archaeological site that we will visit will be Runcurakay (3970 masl) which is another Inca archaeological complex in the form of towers that has a strategic site of surveillance of this valley, then we continue to Chaquicocha where we will have lunch, then we will continue to Phuyupatamarka (which means place above the clouds), on the route we will go through a tunnel carved in rock and we will continue to Wiñayhuayna another wonderful complex where we will spend the night, the tour is 6 hours full of beautiful landscapes, vegetation in Wiñayhuayna. (The third camp may vary to Phuyupatamarca depending on availability).

Day 4 WIÑAYHUAYNA - MACHUPICHU - CUSCO.

Earlier than normal after breakfast we will continue trekking to Machu Picchu, we will pass by the last control and continue to the Inti Punku (sun gate) and then to Machupicchu and you will have the impressive view of the majestic citadel of Machu Picchu, then they will have their guided visit to the place full of history, along with the guide will tour the most important and prominent sites of the ancient Inca city, then you can take more photos, and explore the archaeological site and then return to the town of Aguas Calientes where You can have lunch on your own and finally go to the train station to return to the town of Ollantaytambo and from there by tourist bus to the city of Cusco.

Day 2: SANTA MARIA – SANTA TERESA.

After breakfast, we will start our walk, approx. from 8 to 9 hours of activity between ascents and descents, along we will observe a range of vegetation passing through typical villages of the area, we will also have the opportunity to use part of the ancient Inca Trail that is perfectly preserved where our guide can help us explain in detail we will also observe a wildlife and different types of birds, then arrive at the thermal baths of Cocalmayo the entrance is optional after a perfect bath in Cocalmayo we will arrive to Santa Teresa, where we will spend the second night in a lodging house.

Day 3: SANTA TERESA – HIDROELÉCTRICA – AGUAS CALIENTES.

After breakfast we will go for a 3 hour walk to approx. Where we will also appreciate some fruit plantations and some waterfalls to then reach the town of Hydroelectric where we will have lunch, then we will walk 3 hours along the railway line until we reach the village of Aguas Calientes, where we will spend the third night.

the sunrise will be inside a tropical area full of history and nature there our breakfast awaits us ready to taste and then we will continue our journey towards Machupicchu town to reach this town it will take us an approximate time of 7 hours, passing by the well known center of rest of hydroelectric (service of hydroelectric train - hot waters: optional), doing stops in different places to appreciate simply the landscape and its surroundings full of waterfalls with impressive falls which come from the glaciers, arriving in the afternoon to the mentioned village that popularly It is known as "aguas calientes", there we will spend the night in a hostel at the foot of the Inka citadel of Machupicchu.



TOUR TO PALCCOYO.

A wonderful walk to the "New Rainbow Mountain" through the area of the so called "Cordillera Arco Iris" (Rainbow Mountain Range). This spot has gained fame due to the unprecedented coloring in the sediments of this part of the high Andes. Since agencies in Cusco started to offer it, Rainbow Mountain quickly became one of the most popular day tours from Cusco.

But this tour is different from the regular Rainbow Mountain Trek: it enters the area of the colored mountains through a different access and grants spectacular views of the range. Prepare yourself for a rare and amazing scenery and make sure your camera has enough battery!

Pick-up at your hotel at around 06.00 am.

We leave Cusco with our own private transportation and head to the south of the city into the Southern Valley. We pass valleys, rivers, mountains and some smaller communities. Our starting point is already at 4900 meters above sea level.

We hike uphill for about 45 minutes to the highest point of our excursion which is at 5000 meters. We pass the unique formations of the rainbow mountain range.

The view at the snow-capped Ausangate Mountain is breath-taking. Once we are on the top of our view point, we will have the Vilcanote Mountain range in front of us. You will have all the time to rest and to take pictures. Afterwards, we descent for about 30 minutes back to the starting point. We take the bus to the place to have our lunch and return to Cusco where we arrive around 5.30 pm.
