The itinerary below is a guide and can be tailored to suit your preferences.

Our head guide is an accomplished orchid breeder with over 50 years experience.

- **Day 1.** (½ day) Airport pick up and introduction to Go Wild Peru guides and staff. A optional guided visit to the town's market place and town centre. Welcome dinner.
- **Day 2.** Visit to Orquideas Bella Amazonas, with a conducted tour of the facility. Check local areas for known Terrestrial species.
- **Day 3**. Head to Quincemill to start of a 5-day stay in the Andean foothills, to see rain and cloud forest species.
- **Days 4 to 7.** Starting with the river and forest trails at the lower elevations, and working our way up to the mountains and into the cloud forest trails, many of these are previously unexplored. Option to visit Macapata and the old Cusco road through the High Andes.
- **Day 8**. Return to Puerto Maldonado, stopping where possible at key locations en route.
- **Day 9.** Early start to Ollachea district.
- **Day 10** Visiting near local, newly formed trails. These may or may not be productive, but because these have not been visited by other than locals, there is every likelihood of discovering new never before seen species.

Pricing: Prices start from \$2525.00 per person for bed, meals, transport, guiding fees and housekeeper services.

Note: Days 1 & 11 are, because of flight schedules actually half days. Most flights in and out of Puerto Maldonado are around the middle of the day.

There would also be the added option to drive along the old Cusco road into the High Andes, where the stunning scenery along with some very interesting flora is something not to be missed.

The region is one of the most bio-diverse in South America and a would-be haven for anyone interested in Birds, Ornamental fish, Insects, Orchids, or Reptiles. The cloud forest and mountain scenery is stunning. There is also a well-appointed butterfly farm local to the GWP house, which is also well worth visiting.
