

15 day/14 nights, Fish collecting tour

25th March – 9th April.

The itinerary below is a guide and can be tailored to suit your preferences.

- 26th Day 1.** (½ day) Airport pick up and introduction to Go Wild Peru guides and staff. An optional guided visit to the town's marketplace and town centre. Welcome dinner.
- 27th Day 2.** Fish collecting – area 1. Loboyoc 1, 2 & 3. (End of day set up quarantine.)
- 28th Day 3.** Fish collecting – area 2. Florida 1 & 2. (End of day Water changes in quarantine.)
- 29th Day 4.** Traveling to Quince mil for a three-night stay at the Kuporo Jungle lodge sampling various collecting sights on the way including.
- 30th Day 5.** Fish collecting – area 3 the location for *Corydoras weitzmani* and *C. maculurei*
- 31st Day 6.** Fish collecting – Sampling new areas in the region.
- 1st Day 7.** Return to Puerto Maldonado, collecting at the locations sampled on the outward journey.
- 2nd Day 8.** Rest day – free time, after preparations for scientific export, water changes, visit town centre.
- 3rd Day 9.** Fish collecting – area 4.
- 4th Day 10.** Fish collecting – area 5.
- 5th Day 11.** Visiting near local, newly formed trails. These may or may not be productive, but because these have not been visited by other than locals, there is every likelihood of discovering new never before seen species.
- 6th Day 12.** Fish collecting – area 6.
- 7th Day 13.** Fish collecting – area 7.
- 8th Day 14.** Last minute local collecting and final fish preparation.
- 9th Day 15** (½ day) - Departure.

Pricing: Excluding flights, prices start from \$3275.00 per person for bed, meals, transport, guiding fees and housekeeper services.

Note: Days 1 & 15 are, because of flight schedules actually half days. Most flights in and out of Puerto Maldonado are around the middle of the day.

There would also be the added option to drive along the old Cusco road into the High Andes, where the stunning scenery along with some very interesting flora is something not to be missed.

The region is one of the most bio-diverse in South America and a would-be haven for anyone interested in Birds, Ornamental fish, Insects, Orchids, or Reptiles. The cloud forest and mountain scenery is stunning. There is also a well-appointed butterfly farm local to the GWP house, which is also well worth visiting.

The itinerary will remain flexible and dependant on local conditions and client's desires.
